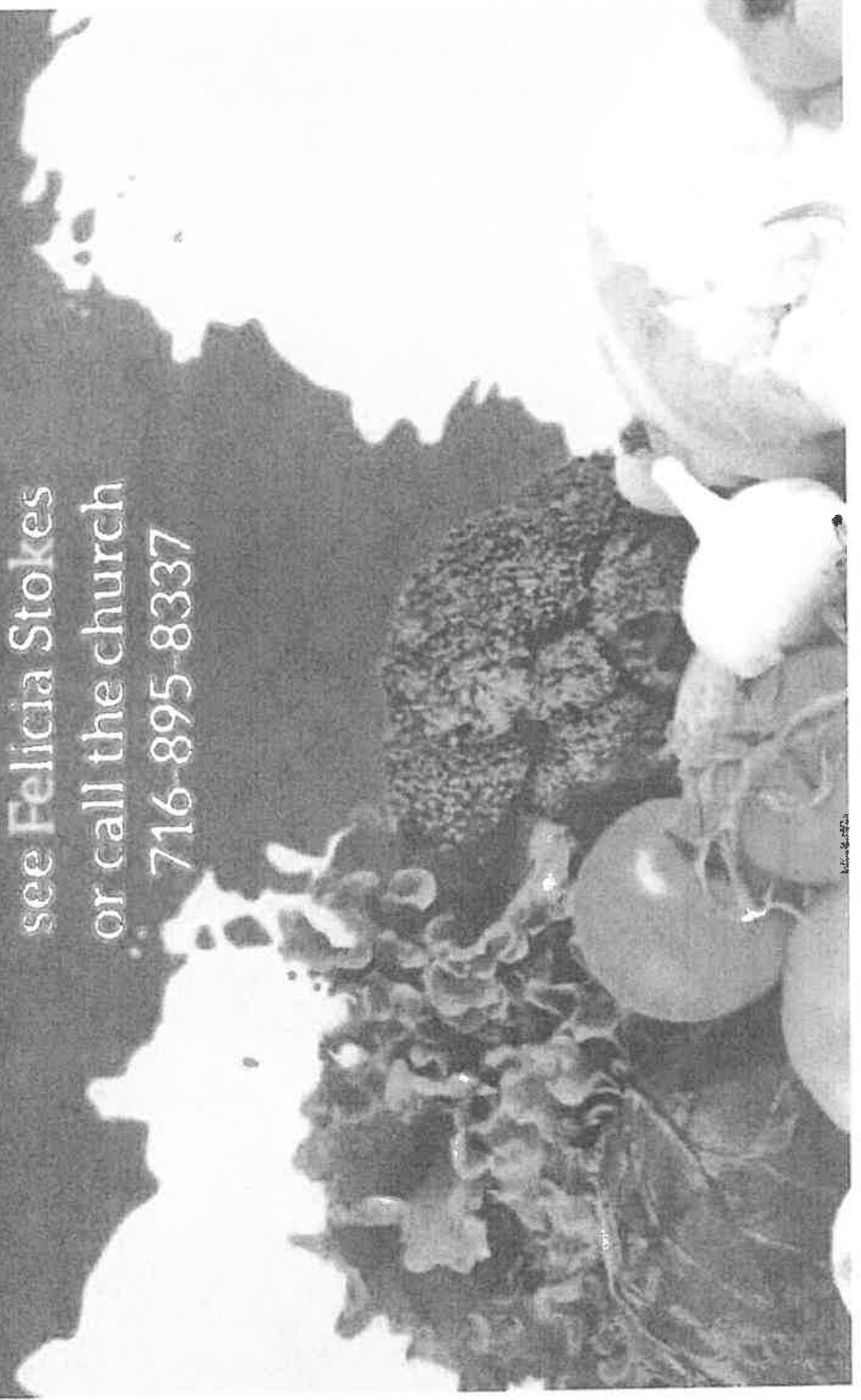

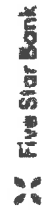

When a government shutdown occurs, federal nutrition assistance programs like SNAP and WIC may be disrupted, causing increased demand on local resources. For immediate food needs, you should turn to non-governmental and community organizations.

Food banks and pantries

- **Feeding America:** The nationwide network of more than 200 food banks and 60,000 partner pantries remains open and is prepared for increased demand from federal employees, contractors, and other affected individuals. You can find your nearest location at feedingamerica.org/needhelp.
- **Local community organizations:** Many churches, community centers, and charities provide direct food aid and meal services. Searching for "food pantry" or "soup kitchen" in your area will help you find local resources.
- **National Hunger Hotline:** If you need immediate assistance finding food resources, you can call the hotline at 1-866-3-HUNGRY (1-866-348-6479).

State-specific and other resources

- **Call 211:** This service can connect you with local agencies and community organizations that offer emergency food assistance in your area.
- **HUD's Find Shelter tool:** This online tool allows you to search for the closest food pantry by entering your zip code.
- **Credit union loans:** For federal employees experiencing delayed paychecks, some credit unions, like Navy Federal and PenFed, are offering low or no-interest loans to help cover essential expenses.

How the current shutdown affects federal programs

As of late October 2025, the shutdown has already impacted or is expected to soon affect federal food assistance.

SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program)

- **October benefits:** Payments for October 2025 were issued on schedule. You can still use any remaining balance on your EBT card during the shutdown.
- **November benefits:** The Trump administration has suspended November SNAP benefits for millions of Americans, stating it will not use available contingency
